In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify the legal voters of the said Town of Littleton, qualified to vote at said meeting for the transaction of Town Affairs, to meet in the Charles Forbes Kaye Gymnasium, Littleton Middle School, 55 Russell Street, in said Littleton, on Saturday, the Ninth day of May, 2009 at 8:00 a.m. by posting a printed copy of this warrant, by you attested, at eight meeting houses, at the Town Office Building on Shattuck Street, at the Post Office at Littleton Common, at the Post Office at Littleton Depot, at the Baptist Church, at the Unitarian Church, at the Catholic Church, at the Congregational Church, and at the Mormon Church, in said Town, seven days at least before the Ninth day of May, 2009, then and there to act on the following articles, viz:

**ARTICLE 1:**

One Moderator for one year; one Selectman for three years; two School Committee members for three years; one Planning Board member for five years; two Park & Recreation Commissioners for three years; two Assessors for three years; one Board of Health member for three years; two Electric Light Commissioners for three years; two Water Commissioners for three years; one Commissioner of Trust Funds for three years; one Commissioner of Trust Funds for two years; two Trustees of the Library for three years; one Cemetery Commissioner for three years
