

## REVIEW OF LITTLETON STATION PARKING CHANGES

- Nordblom has engaged contractor to construct the “upper” lot, paint lines and numbers (numbers will be continuous with the “lower” lot (i.e., continue from 99 – 200). Work on the “upper” lot to be completed by June 18<sup>th</sup>.
- MBTA and Nordblom expect to close on the property on June 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- On or about June 20 MBTA will provide information to all current users of the lower lot and MBTA lots concerning status and new payment methods by means of flyers on cars, info on the MBTA web site ([www.MBTA.com](http://www.MBTA.com)) , notices at the station and other means of outreach. MBTA will take over operations of all parking lots on July 1.
- MBTA parking fee is \$4.00 per day. Customers will be able to pay in a cash honor box, by pay-by-phone and by using a monthly parking pass. Information for pay-by-phone can be found at [www.parkmobile.com](http://www.parkmobile.com) and the monthly program is through Central Parking at [www.parking.com](http://www.parking.com). These web sites will be updated in the near future to reflect these forthcoming changes.
- Nordblom has begun issuing notice of cancellation of leases (monthly parking) to comply with 30 day notice provisions.
- On or about July 1 MBTA will close the Grimes Lane lot (44 spaces) and the platform spaces (8 spaces) to accommodate construction activity on the right-of-way. Three (3) handicap access spaces will be retained at the platform area.
- During station construction the contractor may require using a portion of the “lower” lot, but is required to replace any spaces at an alternate location (nearby). Thus, as of July 1 the Littleton station will have a net increase of approximately 45 parking spaces throughout the station construction.
- Station construction is anticipated to commence on or about Nov. 1, 2011, with a targeted completion date of Spring, 2013. Railroad right-of-way work will commence this summer, requiring the closure of the Grimes Lane lot.
