PUBLIC HEARING AQUIFER DISTRICT SPECIAL PERMIT 169 KING STREET THE BARKING DOG

The Town of Littleton Planning Board will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, February 26, 2009 at 9:15 p.m. in Room 103 of the Shattuck Street Town Hall to consider the application for a Special Permit Pursuant to MGL Chapter 40 A and the Code of the Town of Littleton Zoning, Aquifer and Water Resource District.

Property Location: 169 King Street, Assessor's Map U-38, Parcels 1 and 7A
Owner: Cummins Family Trust, James Cummins Trustee
Applicant: MDM Rodgers Family LP, Jody Rodgers

The application is for an Aquifer District Special Permit to allow a use with impervious area more than 15 percent of the lot area, but less than 30 percent within the Aquifer District to support the re-development of the site at 169 King Street as an indoor kennel, pet daycare, and animal grooming facility with parking and associated site work.

Application and plans can be viewed at the Planning Board and Town Clerk's Office during their business hours. Any person interested or wishing to be heard on the proposed plan should appear at the time and place designated. The Town of Littleton does not discriminate on the basis of disability.
