7:05 Vice Chairmen Peter Yapp opened the meeting with three member present. Ted Doucette had a personal conflict and Joe Presti arrived at 7:10

Minutes

Peter Cassinari mentioned that he wanted to have the conversation between the Board and Savas Danos from Light and Water regarding the Aggregate site included in the minutes from the 26th with his questions regarding smoke monitors and per-chlorate.

Peter Yapp mentioned that since there is not a quorum present the minutes will have to be postponed until the next meeting.

Correspondence

Peter Yapp went through the correspondence which consisted of one failed Title 5 report and several water sample reports.

Board Member Reports

Peter Yapp mentioned that he would wait until Ted was present to discuss the "all boards" meeting that took place on Monday February 1st with Aggregate Industries.

Peter Yapp went over the First Tuesday meeting that took place last week. He mentioned that the solid waste regulations were discussed at the meeting along with Aggregate Industries. Peter mentioned that the solid waste steering committee was mentioned in the First Tuesday meeting which Ted is a member of. Peter mentioned that there will be surveys sent in the electric bills asking residents what they would like for solid waste disposal.

96 Cricket Lane

Ted Trela, the property owner, was present at the time of the discussion. Mr. Trela is before the Board tonight to have two variances approved to install a new well at his home at 96 Cricket Lane. Mr. Trela went through a brief history of the site including the problems with the current well. Gino asked Mr. Trela how deep the new well will be. Mr. Trela informed him that the new well will be 300 feet deep, but with the proposed location needs a variance for the distance from the septic and property lines. Peter Yapp asked Mr. Trela if there was town water available for him in the area. Mr. Trela mentioned that town water is on Spectacle Pond Road, and his neighbor does have it but is not sure if he can hook on to it. Joe mentioned that Mr. Trela to contact Savas Danas from the Light and Water Department to see if it would be possible to hook into town water. Peter Yapp mentioned that the discussion should be continued to the next meeting when Ted Doucette, who has experience in well regulations, is present along with the well driller. The discussion will be continued to the next meeting on February 23rd.

Public Hearing – Local Sewage and Solid Waste Regulations

Peter Yapp opened the public hearing with only the Board members present. Peter Yapp and the rest of the Boards members present read over some of the information that Ted sent in his absence. Peter Yapp mentioned that the current transfer station is under the control of the Board of Selectmen but will come under the Boards control with the changes that are proposed. **Gino Frattallone made a motion, seconded by Joe Presti to continue the public hearing to the next meeting on February 23rd at 8:00 p.m. Vote unanimous.**
