To the Littleton Board of Selectmen:

In response to your own interest, and a request by the Town Administrator, I've sought and received permission from the foundation funding CRWA's work on behalf of Littleton. The Barr Foundation, a local, nationally recognized charitable foundation, is funding CRWA for this project, allowing us to use our engineering, science, and legal expertise to study sewers and the environment in Littleton. As most of you already know, CRWA is a regional environmental nonprofit organization with expertise in water, stormwater, and wastewater infrastructure and regulation. My hope in writing the grant was to supply the Town and the Sewer Feasibility Study Committee with engineering, economic, environmental, and legal information and data that would aid the Committee and the town to make an informed decision on sewers.
