SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION No. 7898

Highway Location: LITTLETON
Authority In Control: TOWN OF LITTLETON
Name of Highway(s): TAYLOR STREET

In accordance with the provisions of MASS. GEN. LAWS Ch. 90, § 18 (2006), the following Special Speed Regulation is:

Hereby Adopted

by the Board of Selectmen

of the Town of Littleton

The following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

TAYLOR STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the Boxborough/Littleton Town Line, thence northerly on Taylor Street
0.36 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.43 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the beginning of state highway.
And beginning again at the end of state highway, thence northerly
0.60 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.32 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the junction of King Street, the total distance being 1.71 miles.

TAYLOR STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of King Street, thence southerly on Taylor Street
0.32 miles at 35 miles per hour
0.60 miles at 40 miles per hour ending at the beginning of state highway.
And beginning again at the end of state highway
0.43 miles at 40 miles per hour
0.36 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the Littleton/Boxborough Town Line: the total distance being 1.71 miles.



Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense MASS. GEN. LAWS Ch. 90, § 14 (2006).
