Allen L. Grant ...of Littleton, WWII Navy veteran; 87

LITTLETON — Allen L. Grant, 87, a longtime Littleton resident, formerly of Ayer, died Sunday, Oct. 29, at his home on Shattuck Street. He was the husband of Gladys (Manley) Grant of Littleton, to whom he was married for 58 years.



He was born in Amesbury on June 7, 1913, a son of the late Ernest and Mina (Morrison) Grant. He grew up in Melrose and was a graduate of Melrose High School, Class of 1931.

Mr. Grant served in the Navy during World War II. He worked for the town of Melrose as a custodian for 20 years. Mr. Grant had also resided in Lunenburg and Ayer, before moving to Littleton in 1969.

In the past, he sang with the Handel and Haydn Society.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two sons, Ernest S. Grant of Hampton, N.H. and George F. Grant of Hernando, Fla.; two daughters, Suzanne L. Chase of Acton and Judith A. Reed of Groton; as well as nine grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

He was also the brother of the late George Grant.
