LITTLETON — Mary (Quirk) Gray, 81, a Littleton resident since 1959, died yesterday, March 13, at the Life Care Center of Nashoba Valley in Littleton. She was the wife of John E. Gray, who died in 1999.

She was born in Woburn on Oct. 5, 1920, daughter of the late Thomas and Anna (Gorman) Quirk. She grew up in Malden and graduated from Malden High School.
