## Carmel 'Candy' Stackpole...worked at Littleton Police Department; 75

LITTLETON — Carmel "Candy" (Ducharme) Stackpole, 75, a resident of Littleton who worked for the police department in town for more than three decades and was a church organist for more than two decades, died Thursday, Feb. 9, at her residence, after a brief illness. She was the wife of Ernest Stackpole.

She was born in Lowell, April 9, 1929, daughter of the late Andrew and Grace (Landry) Ducharme. She grew up in Lowell and Harvard, and graduated from Bromfield Academy in Harvard.

Mrs. Stackpole was best known as being the control center director for the Littleton Police Department, secretary to the police chief and a police matron, from 1962 until her retirement in 1993. Previously, she worked for several years at the town of Little-

ton Welfare Department and also was a telephone operator in Harvard. She also was a receptionist and switchboard operator for many years at the Ayer Community Hospital.

She was a former member of St. Anne Church in Littleton, where she was an organist for more than 20 years as well as the children's choir director. She presently was a member of St. Theresa Church in Harvard.

She enjoyed playing cards, especially canasta, yahtzee and scrabble. She lived for Christmas and her vacations at Cape Cod in the summer.

Besides her husband, she is survived by a daughter, Kathleen (Hennesey) Brule of Harvard; and three granddaughters, Jennifer (Brule) Raymond of Woodstock, Vt., Melissa Brule of Harvard, and Andrea Brule of New York City.
