## Alice Tousignant...raised in Littleton, helped run Chelmsford Taxi; 88

KAUAI, Hawaii — Alice (Rivetts) Tousignant, a Littleton native who helped run her family's North Chelmsford taxi service for many years, died peacefully on Sept. 28 in Hawaii. She was 88.

She was born in Littleton in March 1918, a daughter of Sicilian immigrants, the late Michael and Carmina (Gesualda) Riviezzo. She was raised in Littleton and graduated from Littleton High School.

Mrs. Tousignant had been a longtime bookkeeper at Southwell Mills in Chelmsford, and for many years, Mrs. Tousignant and her family owned and operated the Chelmsford Taxi Service in Vinal Square in the town's North Chelmsford section.

She lived for many years in North Chelmsford and Holden, Mass. She moved to Putnam, Conn., in 2004, and had recently moved

to Hawaii.

Mrs. Tousignant is remembered for being a person who was always there to help others. She had a wonderful smile and was a joy to be around, family members said. In her younger years she loved to dance, and more recently, she enjoyed knitting and crocheting as well as being an avid bingo and card player.

She is survived by three daughters, Lee Lefebvre and her husband John of Farmington, N.H., Connie Fonoimoana and her husband Steve of Kauai, and Maureen Anderson of Putnam, Conn.; seven grandchildren, Robert, Craig, Dawn, John Jr., Carrie, Tamara and Kimberly; six great-grandchildren, Kristine, Chelsey, John III, Paul, Amber and Ashley; and a sister-in-law, Mabel Rivetts. Mrs. Tousignant also leaves many nieces and nephews.
