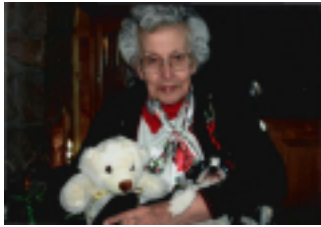


## Mary Croft |
