Leon Griffin, 79, of Main Street Groton, died unexpectedly on October 19 at Mass General Hospital in Boston. He was born Littleton on August 12, 1931 son of the late Ralph and Mary (Bulger) Griffin. He grew up in Littleton and was a graduate of Littleton High School, Class of 1949. He served four years in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean Conflict.

Leon worked as a plumber for Joe Perry Plumbing in Acton until 1965; Hollohan Plumbing in Townsend from 1965-1970; Jim Connolly Plumbing in Fitchburg, Consept Mechanical Services and then Seppala & Aho Construction Co., Inc. of New Ipswich, NH where he managed HVAC projects for 22 years.

He happily devoted this vast experience and enormous talent freely to others. He spent thousands of hours remodeling, repairing and building homes as well as repairing equipment for his family and friends. He was married in 1957 and made his home in Littleton for 5 years and in Groton since 1962.
