Arthur H. Trepanier ... longtime Littleton official; 83

LITTLETON — Arthur H. Trepanier, 83, a former member of the town's Planning Board, Finance Committee and Republican Committee, died Saturday, March 1, at Nashoba Valley Medical Center in Ayer. He was the husband of Alice (Stowell) Trepanier, for 60 years.

He was born in Cambridge on Aug. 2, 1919, a son of the late Emile and Anna (Pronovost) Trepanier. He earned an associate's degree in engineering from Wentworth Institute.

During World War II, he served in the U.S. Army and was discharged as a disabled veteran.

After the war, Mr. Trepanier worked at Hersey Sparling Meter Co. in Dedham for 28 years. From 1969 to 1984, he was an executive assistant in Ayer District Court under the late Judge David B. Williams.

He was a member of St. Anne Church of Littleton and its Holy Name Society.

Mr. Trepanier had lived in Littleton since 1950, and served on its Planning Board for 14 years. He was a member of the Finance Committee for 30 years, and also belonged to the Town Republican Committee.

In addition, he was past chapter commander of the American Legion Post 249, past exalted ruler and past district deputy of the Littleton-Westford Elks Post 1891, and founder, chapter adjutant and past chapter commander and state department commander of Minuteman Chapter 28 of the Disabled American Veterans.

Besides his wife, survivors include two children, Lois Trepanier of Littleton and James Trepanier and his wife, Linda, of Lowell; a sister, Florence Gingras of Westbrook, Maine; a grandson, Edward and his wife, Susan, of Cheshire.

He was also the brother of the late Alfred F. Trepanier.
