

Peter Heidema 26 July, 1985

Peter B. Heidema, 87, of Baldwin Hill Road, Littleton, died Monday, July 26, at Emerson Hospital in Concord after a brief illness.

He was born in the Netherlands, March 21, 1898, son of the late Jan and Cato (Venhuis) Heidema and the husband of the late Geertruida (Jacoba) Heidema who died last year.

He came to the United States in 1926 and attended school and college in the Netherlands.

He was a civil engineer and one of the first to be involved in soil mechanisms and hydroelectric power.

He had lived in Littleton for the past 30 years and had previously resided in Texas.

He was a member of the Boston Academic Society, Professional Society of Engineering, and was a member of the Congregational Church in Littleton.

He leaves two nieces, Cato Ten Hallers-Tjabbes and Carrie Tjabbes, both of the Netherlands.

Funeral services were held at the Badger Funeral Home on Wednesday, July 28. There were no calling hours and burial was at Westlawn Cemetery, Littleton.
