

GEORGE H. HARTWELL, whose funeral services were held in Westlawn cemetery on Saturday last, was a native of this town, being the second son of Shattuck and Catherine (Muzzey) Hartwell. His education was obtained at our public schools, supplemented by a few terms at Westford academy. At one time he was much interested in literary work, and was at all times a reader of the best productions. For several years he was associated with publishing houses in New York and Boston, ~~later~~ making the study of electricity his special pursuit. His lecture on that subject was well received in this and other towns.

For many years he had suffered from some hidden disease that sapped his vital energy, making physical effort almost an impossibility. For several months he had been at the home of his brother, Dr. Edward Hartwell of Boston, until a few weeks ago he was taken to one of the city hospitals, where he died on Thursday, Oct. 12. The funeral services were conducted by his brother-in-law, Rev. John Sewell of St. Albans, Vt.

Mr. Hartwell is survived by his mother, three sisters and two brothers. His age was fifty-two years.
