LITTLETON — Ruth (Woodman) Harrington, 83, died yesterday, March 16, at Apple Valley Continuing Care Center. She was the wife of the late Fredrick Harrington, who died in 1991; they were married in 1933.

She was born in Windham, N.H., on Aug. 28, 1916, a daughter of the late Charles and Bertha (Kimball) Woodman. She spent her early life in Windham and moved to Andover, where she graduated from Andover High School. She lived in Littleton for almost 60 years.

Mrs. Harrington was a secretary for the Littleton Egg Receiving Station for more than 40 years. She later worked at Audrey's Hideaway in West Concord and Kmart in Acton, and was a volunteer at Deaconess Nashoba Hospital in Ayer.

She was a member of the First Congregational Church in Littleton, and of the Willow Rebekah Lodge No. 109 in Concord.
