LITTLETON — Marguerite "Tootie" (Childs) Johnson, 88, a lifelong Littleton resident who worked locally in the retail and manufacturing industries, died Wednesday, Jan. 30, at Suburban Manor Nursing Home in Acton. She was the wife of William W. Johnson Sr., who died in 1978.
