SHELBURNE — Helen J. (DiCiaccio) Knox, 93, a resident of Shelburne and formerly of Littleton, died Sunday, Dec. 4, at her home. For 55 years, she was the wife of Stanley H. Knox, who died in 1997.

She was born in Somerville on Jan. 29, 1912, daughter of the late Ellen and Cosmo DiCiaccio. She attended Somerville public schools.

Before her marriage, Mrs. Knox worked for the Remington-Rand Co.
