LITTLETON — John A. Kimball, 90, of 415 Newtown Road, died yesterday at the Littleton House Nursing Home. He was the husband of the late Priscilla (Stone) Kimball, who died in 1993.

Born Feb. 19, 1906, in Littleton, son of the late Fred and Flora (Merrill) Kimball, he was a lifelong resident of the town.

He graduated from Littleton High School in 1924 and from Massachusetts State College of Amherst in 1928.

He had worked as a dairy farmer for more than 33 years.

Mr. Kimball was a member and Deacon Emeritus of the Littleton Congregational Church, a member of the first Littleton Finance Committee and a town assessor for six years.

The first donor of land to the Littleton Conservation Trust, he was a life member of the Townsend Rod & Gun Club. He also belonged to the Middlesex Farm Bureau.

His survivors include five daughters, Martha R. McHale of Bradenton, Fla., Mary Jane Campbell of Colchester, Vt., Lucinda Ewing of Littleton, Letitia Branigan of Groton and Amy Kimball of Gorham, Maine; a sister, Beulah Swanson of Carlisle; 11 grandchildren; and 12 great-grandchildren.
