AYER — Sang Hyon Kim, 63, an Ayer resident who was a retired technician, died Thursday, Dec. 15, at the University of



Massachusetts — Memorial Hospital in Worcester, after an illness. He was the husband of Hwa Sun (Yang) Kim, to whom he was married for 31 years.

He was born in Korea, Feb. 20, 1942, son of the late Suk Dong and Myung Gun (Kim) Kim. He came to the United States in 1977. He became a naturalized citizen of the United States in 1999.

Mr. Kim resided in Ayer for the past 23 years. Previously, he lived in Shirley.

Before retiring in 1998, Mr. Kim worked many years as a technician for the GenRad Co., in both Concord and Westford.

Mr. Kim was a member of the St. John's Korean Methodist Church in Lexington.

He was an avid fisherman, gardener and storyteller, but his greatest love was for his family.

Besides his wife, he is survived by a son, Hun S. Kim of Ayer; and two sisters, residing in Korea.
