Kevin Robert Keefe, of Marlborough, formerly of Littleton, passed away on Saturday, July 30, 2022, at Marlborough hospital at the age of 69. He was the loving husband of 43 years of Dorothy (Costa) Keefe. Born in Lowell on May 30, 1953, Kevin was the son of the late Charles A. and Georgette (Trudel) Keefe. Raised and educated in Littleton, Kevin attended Littleton High School class of 1971. After graduating from High School, Kevin enlisted in the United States Army and proudly served his country for 6 years and served another 5 years in the Reserves thereafter. By the end of Kevin's service, he had achieved the rank of

Staff Sargent. Kevin met Dotty in 1978 while working as a mechanical designer at AARP Industries and quickly became close friends and companions. Kevin and Dotty's courtship began during their cross-country adventure through the Florida Keys. The two were married soon after on May 20, 1979, at Saint Mary's Church in Billerica.
