NAGOG HILL ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Dear Resident:

The town of Littleton is improving the roadways in your neighborhood. Work is underway to reconstruct Nagog Hill Road. E.H. Perkins Construction Inc. has been hired by the town of Littleton, to complete the project.

IMPROVING YOUR ROADWAY

The roadway improvement project will include the cleaning of the roadway shoulders, installation of drainage pipe, subdrains, catch basins and manholes in certain areas, reconstructing the existing road base and installation of new hot mix asphalt binder and top course on the roadway. Also, a new watermain will be installed from Newtown Road to Berry Bush Road.

HOW WILL THIS WORK AFFECT YOU?

We will make every effort to ensure that you have access at all times. There may be times when the use of detours or road closures may be required to facilitate the work, however local access to and from your property will be maintained. There may be times when the work may temporarily restrict access to your property; however, access will be restored as soon as possible. During paving operations, some extra patience will be required while the paving occurs on the road in front of your property. Because of the narrow roads, the paving operation will take up the full width of the road and may require your direction of travel to be rerouted depending on the location. Police details will be stationed at both ends of the paving operation as well as one officer at the paver. The detail officers will be able to direct you during the few days of paving that will be required. Notices will be given out at least 24 hours prior to paving to minimize any inconvenience. For those residents in the area of the new water main, every effort will be made to ensure that your normal water service is maintained at all times, however there will be instances where the water main will need to be shut down while connections are made, 24 hour notice will be given for these non-emergency shut downs.

PLEASE... WATCH YOUR STEP

We realize that the roadway improvement project will cause some inconvenience for those who live in the area. We are working closely with your local officials and public departments to keep traffic problems to a minimum and to observe all safety precautions. Work areas will be barricaded and carefully marked, but please... watch your step!

IF YOU HAVE A PROBLEM...
