  - ⑥ Expand parking at open space sites, including Handicapped Parking (not mapped)
  - ⑦ Connect trails with neighboring towns
  - ⑧ Find funding other than taxes for open space and recreation (not mapped)
  - ⑨ Create a historic or neighborhood conservation district
