





- CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT DIC SAFE PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATIONS ON SITE. LOCATION OF EXISTING WATER LINES IN IPSWICH RD AND SERVICE TO 2 FOSS PLACE SHALL BE FURNISHED PRIOR TO INSTALLATION OF THE SERVICE TO 1 FOSS PLACE.
- PROPERTY LINES, TOPOGRAPHY AND FIELD LOCATION OF THE BORDERING VEGETATED WETLANDS IS THE RESULT OF A FIELD SURVEY BY PLACES ASSOCIATES.
- PROPERTY LINES SHOWN ON THIS PLAN ARE FOR PERMITTING PROCESS ONLY. THE STAKING OF THE PROPOSED BUILDING OR PROPERTY LINES WILL BE DONE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR AND NOT THE STAMPING PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER.
- WETLANDS FLAGS WERE FIELD VERIFIED BY THE LITTLETON CONSERVATION AGENT ON APRIL 11, 2023.
- NO WORK SHALL OCCUR IN THE 100' BUFFER ZONE TO THE BORDERING VEGETATED WETLANDS UNTIL APPROVED VIA A NOTICE OF INTENT (FOR BUFFER ZONE WORK ON 1 FOSS INCLUDING REMOVAL OF STUDIO AND RESTORATION OF LAWN AREA).
- ALL WATER LINE CONSTRUCTION, MATERIALS AND METHODS SHALL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE LITTLETON WATER DEPARTMENT CRITERIA.
- ANY/ALL CHLORINATED WATER OR DISINFECTANT FOR WATER LINE FLUSHING SHALL BE NEUTRALIZED PRIOR TO DISCHARGE.
- CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR COORDINATING STREET CUT FLAG MEN AND/OR POLICE DETAIL AS REQUIRED BY THE TOWN OF LITTLETON.

NOT TO SCALE




STRAW BALE DIKE
NOT TO SCALE




NOTES:
1. REPLACE STONE & ACCUMULATED DEBRIS, MUD & ENTRAPPED MATERIALS AS IS NECESSARY TO PREVENT TRAFFIC FROM SINKING. REPLACE MONTHLY AS A MINIMUM REQUIREMENT.
2. DISPOSE OF STONE & ENTRAPPED MATERIALS IN A NON SENSITIVE AREA ON-SITE.
3. DO NOT REUSE STONE FOR SAME PURPOSE.
4. ALL TRAFFIC ENTERING / EXISTING SITE TO CROSS TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE


TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE

NOT TO SCALE




TEMPORARY STOCKPILE

PLANTING NOTES:

- THE SPECIES AND VARIETIES LISTED SHALL BE ADHERED TO IN ALL CASES. WHERE A SUBSTITUTION IS PROPOSED ALL SUBSTITUTIONS SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT AND CONSERVATION COMMISSION OR THEIR AGENT.
- THE LOCATION OF PLANTS AND PLANT GROUPINGS SHALL BE MODIFIED IN THE FIELD TO ENSURE EQUAL SPACING, CORRECT PLANT FACING AND TO PROVIDE FIELD ADJUSTMENTS TO ACCOMMODATE CONSTRUCTION CONDITIONS AND OBSTACLES.
- IN CASE OF CONFLICT BETWEEN LANDSCAPE PLAN AND PLANTING SCHEDULE, THE GREATER NUMBER OR LARGER QUANTITY SHALL BE PROVIDED.
- ALL PLANTS AND PLANTING METHODS SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST VERSION OF "RECOMMENDED STANDARD SPECIFICATION FOR PLANTINGS" AS COMPILED AND ISSUED BY THE ASSOCIATED LANDSCAPE CONTRACTORS OF MASSACHUSETTS.
- ALL PLANTS SHALL BE WARRANTED FOR A MINIMUM OF ONE (1) YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ACCEPTANCE BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT. SHOULD ANY PLANTS DIE, EXHIBIT UNDESIRABLE DIE-BACK OR DISEASE DAMAGE, THEY SHALL BE REPLACED AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE OWNER WITH PLANTS MEETING THE ORIGINAL SPECIFICATIONS.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROVISION OF ADEQUATE WATER SUPPLIES TO PLANT MATERIALS UNTIL ACCEPTANCE OF THE LANDSCAPE BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT HAS OCCURRED.
- THE CALIPER OF ALL TREES SHALL BE MEASURED FOUR (4) FEET ABOVE THE ROOT BALL OR GROUND LINE, WHICHEVER IS HIGHER.
- PLANTING SEASONS:
 - SPRING SEASON FOR ALL PLANTING IS FROM APRIL 1ST TO JULY 15TH.
 - FALL SEASON:
 - FOR ALL EVERGREEN MATERIALS IS FROM AUGUST 15TH TO NOVEMBER 15TH.
 - FOR ALL DECIDUOUS TREES, SHRUBS AND GROUNDCOVERS IS FROM AUGUST 15TH TO NOVEMBER 15TH.
- WILDFLOWER MIX SHALL BE EQUAL TO "EASTERN XERICAFE WILDFLOWER SEED MIX" BY AMERICAN MEADOWS, OR APPROVED EQUAL. INSTALL ACCORDING TO MANUFACTURER'S REQUIREMENTS AND AT THE RATE OF APPLICATION NOTED FOR BARE EARTH, NOT RE-ESTABLISHMENT.
- ONCE AREA HAS BEEN SEEDED, CHOPPED STRAW OR OTHER NON-SEED BEARING MULCH SHALL BE APPLIED.

| PIC CO2 | | Picea pungens / Colorado Spruce | 6' Ht. | B&B | 3 | | Native Evergreen, habitat, color and nesting opportunities |
| TIL RED | | Tilia americana 'Redmond' / Redmond American Linden | 1.5 Cal. | B&B | 4 | | Native, Pollinator, habitat and forage, fall color |
