### Steven D. LeClair

LITTLETON — Steven D. LeClair, 45, formerly of Burlington and Concord, died unexpectedly Thursday, June 2, 2005, at Emerson Hospital in Concord. He was the husband of Lesley "Lee" (Loynd) LeClair.

He was born in Stoughton on Sept. 30, 1959, the son of Patricia (Sullivan) LeClair of Concord and the late Roger LeClair. Mr. LeClair was raised in Burlington and Concord, graduating from Concord-Carlisle High School, Class of 1977. He attended Tulane University and Merrimack College. He lived in Littleton since 1993.

Mr. LeClair was employed by Printonics in 1981, where he worked for two years as an account representative. He was then a sales manager for Cable Systems in 1983 and for Techdyne for six years.
