Robert C. Learmonth, 84, of 24 Mattawanakee Trail, Littleton, died February 17, 1989 at his residence after a lengthy illness.

He was born in Kirkwall, Scotland, February 24, 1904, son of the late Alexander and Mary (Clouston) Learmonth.

He came to the U.S. at 17 and served in the U.S. Army, Co. K 13th Infantry.
