Anne (Connelly) Learmonth, 86, of 24 Mattawanakee Trail, Littleton, formerly of Concord, died Saturday at Emerson Hospital, Concord after a lengthy illness.

She was born in Boston on Dec. 2, 1906, daughter of the late John and Mary (Gilligan) Connelly and was the wife of Robert C. Learmonth who died in 1989.

Mrs. Learmonth spent her early life in Lawrence and was a graduate of St. Mary's High School.

She had worked in the woolen mills in Lawrence for several years and was married in 1930.

She and her husband lived in the Concord and Acton areas from 1936 until 1967 when they moved to Littleton. She summered in Dennisport for 33 years.

Mrs. Learmonth was a very active member of St. Anne's Church in Littleton where she was a Eucharistic Minister, a member of the Blessed Virgin Society, 3rd Order of St. Francis, St. Nicholas Committee, Altar Society and Bingo Committee.

She was also a member of the Neighborhood Supper Committee and the West Acton Woman's Club.
