Andrew H. Landini

Andrew H. Landini, 84, of 40 Foster Street, Littleton, died October 19 at the Nashoba Community Hospital in Ayer after a brief illness.

He was born in Somerville September 30, 1902, son of the late Titus and Adalgisa (Ceccarelli) Landini. He spent his early life in Somerville and was a graduate of Somerville High School, Class of 1924.

Andrew graduated from Massachusetts College of Pharmacy in 1924 and worked as a consulting chemist for Skinner & Sherman Co. of Boston for 25 years. He later worked at Veryfine Apple Products as a chemist and general manager for several years. Mr. Landini then worked as a chemist for National Research Corporation in Cambridge from 1956 to 1965. He later worked as a pharmacist for various pharmacies including Dolan Pharmacy of Littleton and

Westford Pharmacy.

He also served on the Littleton Finance Committee and the Board of Health. He was a communicant of St. Anne's Parish in Littleton and a member of the Holy Name Society. He was also a member of the American Chemical Society and the American Pharmaceutical Society.

His survivors include his wife Sylvia (Priest) Landini of Littleton; a son, Edward A. Landini of Sterling; and two daughters, Mrs. Edward (Mary) Doyle 3rd, of Dedham and Mrs. Roy (Jane) Karlson of Hudson.

He is also survived by eight grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

A funeral Mass was held at St. Anne's Church, Littleton. Burial was at Westlawn Cemetery.
