Joseph J. Mrazik, 75, of 140 Goldsmith Street Littleton died unexpectedly Feb. 15 at his home.

He was born in Stamford Connecticut, October 18 1909, son of the late John and Susan (Kapusta) Mrazik and was the husband of the late Mary (Volna) Mrazik.

Joe had made his home in Littleton for the past 35 years. He had worked as a tool and dye maker for Avco Corporation of Wilmington for many years before his retirement ten years ago. He spent his earlier life in Connecticut and moved here to work for Warren Manufacturing. Joe
