Bradley J. Madge...Littleton, former Ayer police officer, pilot; 54

LITTLETON — Bradley J. Madge, 54, died unexpectedly Monday, Oct. 17, at Emerson Hospital in Concord. He was the husband of Leslie Sleeper Madge, to whom he was married for 31 years.

He was born on Nov. 23, 1950, son of John and Lorraine (Baer) Madge of Westwood. He grew up in Westwood, graduating from Westwood High School in 1968. He later received a bachelor's degree in economics from Northeastern University. In 1980, he graduated from the Massachusetts Police Academy, as the oldest student in the academy. Before moving to Littleton in 1982, he lived in Phillipston.

For several years, Mr. Madge worked for the Templeton Police Department. Before his

retirement in 1994, he was a sergeant with the Ayer Police Force.

He later received an aircraft-mechanic certification from East Coast Aerotech. He also received a pilot's license. For the past year, Mr. Madge was a teacher at Wyotech, formerly East Coast.

He was a member of the Massachusetts Retired Police Association and enjoyed flying.

Besides his wife and parents, survivors include a son, Brian J. Madge of Littleton; a daughter, Kathleen N. Madge of Littleton; six brothers and sisters, Heather Hansen of Lebanon, N.H., Kirk Madge of Walpole, Randall Madge of Millis, Craig Madge of Pittsburgh, Amy Madge of Westwood and Johanna Madge of Medway.
