Arthur A. MacMelville, 72, of 10 Pinecrest Road, Littleton, who retired from Raytheon eight years ago, died Wednesday at Deaconess Hospital in Boston.

He was the husband of Marjorie (Preston) MacMelville.

He was born in Somerville Sept. 6, 1920, son of the late William and Beatrice (Gobel) MacMelville and had spent his early life in Dorchester, graduating from Dorchester High School in 1937.

Mr. MacMelville served in the U.S. Army during World War II.

Before retirement eight years ago, he was a logistics engineer at Raytheon Company for 20 years.

He was an active member of the Littleton Congregational Church, a member of the Council on Aging, a volunteer for the Neighborhood Supper and Meals on Wheels program.
