

John D. MacDougall ...retired hospital administrator

LITTLETON — John D. MacDougall II, 68, of 5 Elmwood Road, died yesterday at Emerson Hospital in Concord.

 He was born in Somerville on Jan. 29, 1927, son of the late John and Mary (Kiley) MacDougall.

He spent his early life in Watertown and was a graduate of Watertown High School. He then served in the U.S. Marine Corps during World War II, serving in Okinawa.
