

Mar. 19, 1884 LITTLETON.

DIED, March 9, Mr. Thomas Nye, aged eighty-four years, nine months. Mr. Nye was born in Sandwich in 1802, and when a young man he came with his parents to Littleton, where he has resided for the greater part of his life since. His father being a sea captain, he naturally followed the sea during his early manhood, until about the time of his marriage with Miss Mary Tuttle, of Littleton. Mr. Nye was one of the most highly esteemed men in town, having for years held positions of trust. He was for forty-nine years a prominent and valued member of the Baptist church here, having the welfare of the church almost first in his heart, and willing to sacrifice all for the cause of Christ. He was an earnest, consistent Christian, greatly beloved by all who knew him, and his words of counsel have encouraged many a young person just starting in life, as well as older ones. Mr. Nye was a great sufferer during the last few months of his life, but was so tenderly cared for by his daughters that his life seemed to be prolonged by their care. He leaves a son and five daughters to mourn their loss, together with a host of friends who feel that the loss is one in common. His funeral occurred Saturday from the Baptist church, Rev. R. G. Johnson, officiating.
