Richard J. O'Reilly...Pepperell, was manager of Stone Edge Design Co.; 52


PEPPERELL — Richard J. O'Reilly, of Pepperell and a former resident of Leominster, Lowell and Billerica, who was a manager for a local company, died Friday, Dec. 30, at the Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston, after a brief illness. He was 52.

He was born in Peterborough, N.H., July 28, 1953, son of the late Roy F. O'Reilly and Gertrude A.
