LITTLETON — John J. O'Loughlin, 93, of Littleton, died of complications of pneumonia at Concord Health Care Center in Concord on January 30, 2011. He was born in Lowell on February 7, 1917 and was the son of the late Arthur and Mary (Brady) O'Loughlin. John grew up in Lowell and was a graduate of Lowell High School.



He worked as an accountant at Fort Devens before joining the U.S. Army during WW2. After the war he worked at Ft Devens in Civil Service as a purchasing agent and retired in 1972.

In 1938 he married Laura Morel also of Lowell, and moved to Littleton in 1950. John was a member of St. Anne's Church in Littleton and a member of Littleton Westford Elks. He was an avid tennis player and played well into his 80's.
