# William Oldenquist

## ...worked as Littleton police officer

William Oldenquist Sr., 60, of 12 Long Lake Road, died at the Deaconess-Nashoba Hospital in Ayer on May 26.

He was born in Concord on Feb. 19, 1933, son of the late Edward and Dorothy (Elmes) Oldenquist. He spent his early life in Concord and attended the Concord school system.

Mr. Oldenquist served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He also worked for Frank Maurer Co. as a trucker and H.P. Knowles as an oil delivery man.

Mr. Oldenquist worked for the town of Littleton as a police officer from 1968 until 1977 when he retired because of an injury. He made his home in Littleton for the past 22 years and was a member of the Littleton Patrolmen's Association and the Massachusetts Police Association. He was also a communicant of St. Anne's Church and was a former president of the American Legion Post #249.

He is survived by his wife of 36 years, Algeline (Lombardo) Oldenquist of Littleton; three sons, Edward C. Oldenquist and William H. Oldenquist Jr., both of Littleton, and Daniel R. Oldenquist of Boxborough; and a sister, Joyce Hopkins of New Ipswich, N.H. He is also survived by eight grandchildren and was the brother of the late Geraldine Hewitt.
