Obituary.—Miss Sarah E. Proctor died on Sunday last, June 10, at the age of 33 years. Miss Proctor was born in Littleton in the north part of the town, where her father now resides, and on the place which has been in the Proctor family from the earliest settlement of this town. Here was erected one of the first five log houses built in Littleton, and Mr. Joel Proctor has in his possession one of the first deeds of land ever given in Littleton.

For the past four years Miss Proctor has been an invalid. Previous to that time she was one of our most successful teachers in the public schools. She was well qualified for a teacher both by education and natural adaptation and entered upon her chosen labors with enthusiasm. Miss Proctor was a patient sufferer through the long years of her sickness, not a murmur of complaint escaping her lips, and when the hour of her departure came she was ready to go, and even welcomed the messenger of death which was to release her from all suffering and take her to a home of peace and joy forever.
