## Anthony Priest

Anthony F. Priest Sr., 71, of Arc Place, Littleton, died at Emerson Hospital in Concord, Oct. 22, after a lengthy illness. He was born in Cambridge, September 30, 1913, son of the late Francis and Mary (Portanova) Priest. Anthony spent his early-life in Cambridge where he attended Webster Grammar School and was a graduate of Rindge High School. He served in World War II with the U.S. Marines and later worked as a roofer for most of his life for Gilbert & Becker, Inc. A resident of Littleton for 26 years, Mr. Priest was a member of Local 33 Roofers Union, a member of the Littleton-Westford Elks, and a communicant of St. Anne's Parish in Littleton.
