Mary F. Pickard... 59-year Littleton resident, nurse, St. Anne member; 87

LITTLETON — Mary F. (Condon) Pickard, 87, a resident of Littleton for nearly six decades, died yesterday, Sept. 28, at Life Care Center of Nashoba Valley in Littleton.

She was the wife of Albert E. Pickard, who died in 2000.

She was born in Harvard, Feb. 22, 1919, daughter of the late Patrick and Julia Ann (Herlihy) Condon. She grew up in Harvard, and graduated from Bromfield Academy in 1935. She then graduated from Mount Auburn Hospital School of Nursing in 1939.

She made her home in Littleton, after her marriage to Albert in 1947.

From 1940 to 1948, Mrs. Pickard was a medical secretary for Dr. Samuel Chalfen in Cambridge. Previously, she worked at Mount Auburn Hospital for a year as an assistant head nurse.

Mrs. Pickard was a member of St. Anne Church of Littleton, and a member of the Ladies Sodality.

She enjoyed playing bingo, knitting and raising her children.

She is survived by four sons and three daughters-in-law, David E. and Martha Pickard of Gardner, Charles H. and Tish Pickard of Littleton, Albert A. and Deb Pickard of Townsend, and Daniel H. She was also the sister of the late Sylvester Condon.
