Minnie Rivetts

... lifelong resident of Littleton; 90

LITTLETON — Minnie (Cantino) Rivetts, 90, of Littleton, died Thursday, March 15, at the Deaconess Nashoba Hospital in Ayer. In 1929, she married Clement Rivetts, who died in 1975.
