## ... worked at Littleton Egg Station

James E. Budra, 49, of 69 Great Road, Littleton died unexpectedly on Tuesday, May 18 at Emerson Hospital in Concord.

He was born in Cambridge on May 29, 1943, son of Constance (Fucile) Budra and the late Frank Budra. He spent his early life in Cambridge and attended Rindge and Latin High School.

Mr. Budra worked for Whitehall Liquor Company in Boston and Littleton Egg Station for many years. He had made his home in Littleton from 1969 to 1984, Chelmsford from 1986 to 1989 and in Littleton again for the past

two years. He was a member of St. Anne's Church in Littleton.

In addition to his mother, Constance (Fucile) Budra, Mr. Budra is also survived by his wife of 27 years, Barbara (McLaughlin) Budra; a son, Robert Budra; and a daughter, Debra Budra, all of Littleton.
