

Everett L. Broughton, 82

LITTLETON - Everett L. Broughton, 82, a resident of Littleton since 1980, and a resident of Acton 30 years prior, died Sunday, Oct. 26, 2008, at Life Care Center in Littleton.

He was the husband of Beverly (Crain) Broughton, who died in 2006.

He was born in Fall River on Dec. 11, 1925, son of the late Thomas and Annie (Ripley) Broughton.

He graduated from Durfee High School in 1943 and from Boston University in 1949 with a Bachelor of Science degree in business.

He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II where he saw action at Okinawa aboard the USS Auburn, as a radioman

He was past president of the Concord Lions Club and the Concord Men's Club at the Trinitarian Congregational Church in Concord.
