Urbano Souza

Urbano "Herb" Souza, 66, of 38 George St., Littleton, died at St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Brighton on Jan. 2.

He was born in New Bedford Oct. 22, 1927, son of the late Urbano and Mary (Perriera) Souza. He spent his early life in New Bedford and served in the U.S. Army during WW II. Mr. Souza served in Germany where he met his wife Waltraut, and was married in 1949.
