## Beverly Broughton...of Littleton, formerly of Acton, was clerk; 81

**LITTLETON** — Beverly (Crain) Broughton, 81, a resident of Littleton and formerly of Acton, who worked for an insurance company in Acton, died Saturday, Feb. 11, at Emerson Hospital in Concord. She was the wife of Everett L. Broughton.

She was born in Wakefield, March 15, 1924, daughter of the late Orvis and Mary (Boyce) Broughton. She grew up in Wakefield and graduated from Wakefield High School in 1942, and later from Malden Business School.

She was married in 1949, and had made her home in Acton for 31 years, before moving to Littleton 24 years ago.

Before retiring in 1986, Mrs. Broughton was a clerk for 10 years at Lowden Insurance Co. in Acton. Previously, she was a private

secretary for the American Board of the Commission for Foreign Ministries for several years.

Mrs. Broughton assisted the Trinitarian Congregational Church in Concord for 20 years with senior citizens teas.

She enjoyed photography and loved to travel. She was also an avid reader who loved country music and her family.

Besides her husband, she is survived by three sons and two daughters-in-law, James E. and Delphie Broughton of Apex, N.C., Scott A. Broughton of Salem, Chris E. and Lisa Broughton of Groton; two grandchildren, Lyle J. and Julia M. Broughton; and a sister, Shirley Loveys of Goffstown, N.H.
