# Barbara Shea

*formerly of Littleton, MA, former teacher,  
honored for work in curriculum development*

HUDSON, NH — Barbara (Read) Shea, 81, of Hudson NH, died on August 16, 2011, at St. Joseph's Hospital in Nashua, NH



She was born in Brooklyn, NY on July 22, 1930, daughter of the late Charles and Hazel (Bradley) Read, and was the wife of the late William R. Shea Jr., who died in 2004. She grew up in Littleton, MA and graduated from the Littleton Public School System. Barbara received her BA in Education from Framingham State College and her MA in Education from Lowell University.

She taught fifth grade in Lexington from 1951-1955 and fifth grade in Boxborough from 1967 – 1990. Barbara was also Assistant to the Principal in Boxborough for many years and was a recipient of the Lucretia Crocker Fellowship from the Commonwealth of MA, 1986-1987, for innovative work in curriculum development.

She has made her home in New Hampshire since 1972. She was member of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Nashua, NH, the Nature Conservancy, Sierra Club and Defenders of Wildlife. Barbara was also an avid Red Sox Fan.
