

MRS. ISABELLA SHARP

(MOTHER OF MRS. JAMES A. EWING)

DIED MARCH 15, 1923

Mrs. Isabella Sharp passed away at 12.30 Thursday morning at the age of 87 years, 2 months and 14 days. She had been failing all winter and for eight weeks had been confined to her bed. Her daughter, Mrs. James Ewing, with whom Mrs. Sharp made her home, and other members of the family devotedly cared for her throughout her long illness and the last few weeks the services of a nurse were required. The deceased was a native of Hampton, New Brunswick. Her husband died many years ago and for twelve years she had made her home with Mr. and Mrs. Ewing. Other children surviving Mrs. Sharp are two sons living in the west and a daughter, Mrs. Gay of Nashua. There are also twelve grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

The funeral will be held from her late home at James A. Ewing's, Goldsmith street, Saturday afternoon at 2.30 o'clock, and will be conducted by Rev. Mr. Margerson of Springfield, N. Y. Burial will be in Westlawn cemetery.
