Richard H. Schwieger, 81, command sergeant major, retired, formerly of Littleton, died at Hale Memorial Hospital in Haverhill on Thursday, Dec. 28, 2000. He was the husband of the late Josephine (Sewak) Schwieger.

Born in Burlington, Iowa, on June 19, 1919, he grew up in Burlington and was a graduate of Burlington High School. He served 30 years in the U.S. Army and was stationed in Africa during World War II and in Korea during the Korean conflict. After his retirement in 1967, he worked as a personnel director at Westboro State Hospital for almost 20 years.

Mr. Schwieger is survived by two sons, Joseph Schwieger of Melbourne, Fla., and Jeffrey Schwieger of Shirley; two daughters, Johanna Johnson of Scottsdale, Ariz., and Jamie Schwieger of Shirley; six grandchildren and one great-grandchild. He was the grandfather of the late Jeffrey G. Schwieger.
