William J. Schmidt...Littleton resident, WWII Navy veteran; 82

LITTLETON — William J. Schmidt, 82, a Littleton resident and a World War veteran, died Thursday, Feb. 22, at home after a lengthy illness. He was the husband of Virginia (May) Schmidt, to whom he was married for 56 years.

 He was born in Newark, N.J., on Jan. 31, 1925, son of the late William J. and Ruth (Appenzeller) Schmidt. He was raised in Newark and graduated from Newark High School.

Mr. Schmidt joined the U.S. Navy during World War III and served in the South Pacific aboard Landing Ship Tank 1024. He enjoyed yearly reunions with his fellow veterans and Mr. Schmidt was also an active member of the Westford Disabled American Veterans.

After the war, he became a facilities manager for Riverside Press, Cuneo Press, Metropolitan



Greeting Card Co., and the Atheneum House in Cambridge. He retired at the age of 72.

He loved boating, fishing, scuba diving, snowmobiling and traveling with his wife.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his children and their spouses, Lorelyn Brooks and her husband Robert of Weymouth, William J. Schmidt and his wife Mary of West-
