



Edwin "Ed" Roy Shaffer passed away on Wednesday, May 4, 2022, at the age of 92 at Lowell General Hospital. Ed was the loving husband of the late Mildred J. (Fenton) Shaffer for 56+ years.

Born on August 09, 1929, in Boston, Edwin was the son of the late Roy and Muriel (Crossman) Shaffer.
