LITTLETON — Kathleen M. (Meehan) Boyle, 67, of Littleton died Thursday at her home, after a lengthy illness. 8-31-95

She was born in New York City on July 3, 1928, daughter of the late Thomas and Delia Meehan. She graduated from St. Augustine's Elementary School and Cathedral High School in the Bronx. She lived in New Jersey and California before settling in Littleton 19 years ago.
